Hello everyone? I am Sokola Rimba. Have you ever heard of me? I am a jungle school for Orang Rimba. Orang Rimba or people of the forest are nomadic tribes living in the rainforests in Jambi on Sumatra Island in Indonesia. Do you know who developed me and when I was developed? I was established in 2003 by Butet Manurung and her four fellow educators. Well, now I will tell you more about me. Please listen carefully.

I am a jungle school and also a non-profit organisation. My goal is to prepare isolated communities to deal with the modern world. The people of the jungle learn and study with me. As a jungle school, I provide educational opportunities for indigenous peoples in remote areas of Indonesia. After studying with me, many children in these communities can read and write. They also learn counting. The teachers use a practical 'reading-writing-counting' method to teach my students. The methods were developed by Butet Manurung during the years she stayed in the jungle. The children in

the forests are very happy to study.

In 2013, a great director, Riri Riza made a film about me and my history. This movie is titled "Sokola Rimba". It won some movie awards. I am really happy about it because now I can reach more communities across Indonesia. I also help more than 10.000 people, both children and adults, to read and write. I really hope more people will benefit from me.
