C. MONOLOGUE SCRIPT

While he was looking for him, he passed a beautiful village with green fields, crystal clear rivers, fountains, and buildings typical of rural England. This village was like the one Aling, his one and only love, always spoke about. But he was never sure if the village she called Edensor was real. He then asked a passer-by who answered, "Sure love, it is Edensor." See, it is amazing right? I hope you enjoy lkal's adventures and learn from him through my mosaics.
