C. MONOLOGUE SCRIPT

Have you ever been on a plane before? You must be familiar with that sound. What planes do you usually see at the airport? Boeing, or Airbus? You're right. Boeing and Airbus planes are the most widely used aircraft in the world. But do you know our country has also manufactured airplanes?

It was a bright morning at Husein Sastra Negara Airport in Bandung on 10 August 1995, when President Suharto, the First Lady Tien Suharto, and many other leading figures in the country were present. They gathered at the airport tower to witness the first Indonesian aircraft flight. It was my flight. I am N 250 Gatotkaca. The name "Gatotkaca" was inspired by the name of a famous Javanese puppet character, who is famous for his flying ability.

The airport tower resounded with cheers and applause as my pilot Erwin Danuwinata and my co-pilot Sumarwoto managed to get me up into the sky. Some even broke down in tears and hugged each other after seeing the plane they had been working so hard on for years, finally flying. What a

proud moment!

I was initiated by Habibie, the Research and Technology Minister at the time, who dreamt of building an Indonesian aircraft industry. The letter N in my name N250 represents Nurtanio, the company's nickname, whereas number 2 signifies the double engine and 50 means 50 passengers. The company planned to produce more advanced aircrafts based on my prototype, but sadly it was cancelled the following year due to the monetary crisis in Asia.

The cancellation didn't stop PT Dirgantara Indonesia, the new name of the company, from producing Indonesian aircraft after the situation improved. Now, they're manufacturing my successors; N219, a remote area transportation aircraft; NC212, a civilian and military aircraft; N235, a multi-purpose aircraft; and CN295, a military aircraft for military operations and humanitarian missions.
